Member Code of Conduct

Members:

- are expected to know, follow and promote the ethos of the u3a movement at every opportunity. This ethos is one of self-help using the wealth of experience and knowledge for the benefit of all. Ashton in Makerfield & District u3a (A in M u3a) is an organisation run by members for members
- must always act in the best interests of A in M u3a and the u3a Movement, strive to uphold its reputation and never do anything which could bring their own, another u3a or the u3a Movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
- are expected to use A in M u3a's resources responsibly and only to further its stated charitable objects/purposes.
- are expected to reflect the current organisational policy of A in M u3a, regardless of whether it conflicts with their personal views.
- are expected to abide by A in M u3a's procedures and practices.
- are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.
